A clean-lined, contemporary home sited in the north desert area of Scottsdale, Painted Sky was designed around specific art pieces. The architecture aims for maximum openness and function, with little hallway obstruction. Public areas are sheltered from the sun, yet deliver the indoor/outdoor relationship that is so much a part of life here. In fact, the shaft running through the pool and into the house is in direct alignment with the rising sun at seasonal solstice.

Low profile and integration of curves and straights adds interest approaching the house. Curves are also reflected in trellis protection for the guest parking area. The front entry is flanked by a wall with color slots, which add depth and interest. And the front drive fits the home snugly into its surroundings.
